



## Process for BSL registered boxers competing outwith Scotland.

### Attentional all members

The following information is designed to explain the new process applicable, with immediate effect, for Boxing Scotland Ltd (BSL) registered Boxers seeking to participate outwith Scotland (while not representing Scotland through BSL).

The process will be as follows:

1. An individual permission request form has been developed and **must** be completed for every boxer seeking to compete outwith Scotland;
2. If, for example, a club has 10 boxers competing in the same event, ten individual forms must be completed;
3. The club secretary must request the form from their respective District Secretary.
4. The document must be **fully** completed and signed by the boxer, club secretary and the coaches who will second the boxer at the event in question;
5. Completed and signed forms must returned to the District Secretary and to [marianne.mcmahon@boxingscotland.org](mailto:marianne.mcmahon@boxingscotland.org) immediately thereafter, either by post or email;
6. All completed forms must be received a minimum of two weeks prior to the bout(s) taking place, otherwise they will not be considered;
7. All request forms received within the identified timescale above will be considered by District Executives and the decision communication as soon as possible back to the Club Secretary. It will be the responsibility of the Club Secretary to inform both the boxer(s) and second(s);
8. Boxers and Seconds **must always** wear their club attire while acting as a second outwith Scotland.
9. The seconds present the confirmation from the District Secretary showing permission has been granted to box on the evening of the bout and to the Supervisor of the show/tournament;
10. One of the seconds must provide District Executives with every bout result for every boxer granted permission within seven days of the show/tournament concluding.
11. A similar pro-forma has been developed for BSL affiliated clubs wishing to invite non Scottish boxers to compete in their shows. Should this be the case, a fully completed copy of the permit granted to stage the show **must** be provided with the request form prior to being considered.

Any club found not to be following the above process/criteria which allows it Boxer(s) to take part in bouts, without prior BSL sanction, will be:

- In breach of its BSL insurance cover;
- be subject to further disciplinary sanctions which may result in the suspension of its BSL affiliation.
