



Boxing Scotland Boxing Scotland Anti-Doping Policy

Boxing Scotland supports the fight against doping in sport.

Boxing Scotland's Anti-Doping policy is as follows:

All members of Boxing Scotland as defined in the Boxing Scotland Limited Articles of Association, together with any boxer or coaching personnel forming part of or associated with a Boxing Scotland delegation to any AIBA competition (whether or not they are also a member of Boxing Scotland), are required to abide by and will, by virtue of their membership of Boxing Scotland or participation in a Boxing Scotland delegation (as appropriate), be treated as bound by:

- The World and UK Anti-Doping Rules and Regulations; and
- The AIBA Anti-Doping Rules (which, in the event of any inconsistency, shall prevail).

Infringements of these Rules will be addressed and sanctioned in accordance with those Rules and may also be considered to be a violation of the Boxing Scotland Code of Conduct giving rise to separate disciplinary measures.

- All Athletes, Athlete Support Personnel and other Persons must cooperate fully with any anti-doping investigations or proceedings, whether conducted by UK Anti-Doping or any other competent body. Failure to do so without acceptable justification may be treated as misconduct under Boxing Scotland Code of Conduct and may be sanctioned accordingly.
- In the event that a person who is subject to Boxing Scotland jurisdiction commits an act of misconduct that relates to anti-doping but does not amount to a violation of UK Anti-Doping Rules/the Anti-Doping Rules of the Boxing Scotland, Boxing Scotland may bring disciplinary proceedings against that person for such misconduct under Boxing Scotland Code of Conduct and they may be sanctioned accordingly.

...[A]ll members of Boxing Scotland as defined in the Boxing Scotland Limited Articles of Association, together with any athlete or athlete support personnel forming part of or associated with an Boxing Scotland delegation to an AIBA competition (whether or not they are also a member of Boxing Scotland), are required to abide by and will, by virtue of their membership of Boxing Scotland or participation in an Boxing Scotland (as appropriate), be treated as bound by:

- The UK Anti-Doping Rules; and
- The AIBA Anti-Doping Rules (which, in the event of any inconsistency, shall prevail).

Boxing Scotland also reserves the right to refuse membership to any person who infringes the above Rules and Regulations.
