



Boxing Scotland Elite Golden Gloves Championships 2025

Event Information

DATES;

Preliminary Rounds - Friday 14th, Saturday 15th and Sunday 16th March 2025.

Elite Golden Gloves Finals – Saturday 22nd March 2025.

VENUE;

Ravenscraig Regional Sports Facility, 1 O'Donnell Way, Wishaw, Motherwell, ML1 2TZ.

WEIGH-IN;

Friday 14th March – Scales will be open **3:30-5:30pm**, boxing to commence at **7:30pm**.

Saturday 15th and Sunday 16th March – Scales will be open **8-10am**, boxing to commence at **Noon** each day.

Weigh-in details for the Elite Golden Gloves Finals will be confirmed in due course.

Each entrant must produce their Boxing Scotland Medical Record Card (SME2) at the weigh-in and each boxer must be registered for the 2024-25 season.

Boxers only weigh-in on days that they are set to box.

WEIGHT ALLOWANCE;

There is **no** weight allowance for boxers at the Elite Golden Gloves Championships.

HANDS WRAPS;

Professional hand wraps are **mandatory** for all boxers competing in the Elite Golden Gloves Championships. Clubs must provide their own hand wraps for the Championships. Seconds Out Fight Store will have a stall at the Championships where hand wraps can be purchased.

All hand wraps must be signed off by a designated Boxing Scotland representative before boxers put on gloves.

EQUIPMENT;

All gloves and headguards will be provided by Boxing Scotland for the Championships.

EVENT KIT;

Scotland National team kit must not be worn by any boxer or coach.

CHANGING ROOMS/WARM UP AREA;

Boxers must use the male and female changing rooms provided, no changing will be allowed in the warm-up area. Please note, changing rooms should not be used as a sitting/warm-up area by any boxer or coach.

COACHES;

Coaches **must** be in possession of their Boxing Scotland 2024/25 Coach Registration badge at the event in order to receive a coach band for each day of the Championships.

Access to the warm-up area/Field of Play will not be permitted without a coach band.

Coach bands will be distributed at the Championships on each day at the following times only;

Friday 14th March – **5:30-6:30pm.**

Saturday 15th and Sunday 16th March – **10-11am.**

Sunday 22nd March – **5-6pm.**

Please note, the number of Coach Bands allocated to your club on each day of the Championships will be based on the number of Boxers you have competing on that day.

OFFICIALS;

Dougie Fraser and Norman Watt will be the Event Supervisors for the Championships.

Officials attendance at the Elite Golden Gloves Championships is by invitation only.

SPECTATOR TICKETS;

Preliminary rounds (14-16th March);

Adult: One Day Ticket - £20, Two Day Ticket - £35, Three Day Ticket £45.

Children Under 16: One Day Ticket - £10, Two Day Ticket - £15, Three Day Ticket £20.

Elite Golden Gloves Finals spectator ticket information to be confirmed in due course.

Spectator tickets are non-refundable and non-transferable.

Boxers who are entered into the competition will be granted free access to the venue on weekends that they compete in the Championships. This only covers weekends that the boxer is set to compete, and not the duration of the Championships. The boxers should approach the ticket desk for entry, who will have a list of boxers who are eligible for access on that day.

Please note, Boxing Scotland affiliated coaches/officials who are not actively working at the competition will need to pay spectator fees in order to be granted access to the facility.

PARKING;

There is plenty of car parking available at Ravenscraig which is free of charge.

REFRESHMENTS;

Ravenscraig has a Café on-site, whilst there are also several amenities close to Ravenscraig. Please note, there is no cash machine on site at the venue.

SECURITY;

Spotlight Event Security will oversee all security within the boxing venue.

MEDICAL;

Fully GMC Registered and Approved Boxing Scotland Doctors will oversee all medical provisions at the event.

MASTER OF CEREMONIES;

Mr Craig Stephen.

PHOTOGRAPHER;

A photographer will be present at the Championships and by entering the competition/venue you consent to being photographed at the event.

STREAMING;

The Championships will be streamed on the Boxing Scotland Official YouTube channel.

RUNNING ORDERS/RESULTS;

Results and updated Running Orders will be published on the Boxing Scotland website after each day of the competition.

ZERO TOLERANCE;

A Zero tolerance will be observed by Boxing Scotland on foul and abusive behaviour for all members and spectators at the Championships.

MEDICAL EMERGENCY;

Boxing Scotland reserve the right to bring the Championships to a premature end as a result of medical emergencies or any health and safety concerns.
